Publishing with ACER

The first step for an author is to make a preliminary enquiry, preferably by email, to the **ACER Press** Publishing Manager. (See reverse for contact information.) If your proposal fits our publishing program, we will ask you to complete a Publishing Proposal form, accessible at www.acer.edu.au/authors. This form provides us with the information necessary to make a formal decision on your proposal.

We also actively commission work from authors who we believe can produce products that meet specific market needs. In these cases, authors are asked to prepare a proposal for further consideration.

In all cases, proposals and finished manuscripts are subject to a rigorous review process where ACER staff and external experts assess the work and may suggest improvements. As a further guide, the chart opposite shows the **ACER Press** publishing process from the proposal stage to contract and commencement of production.
