findings from the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS

2002/03) at 02:00am AEDT on Wednesday 15 December 2004.

The study assessed mathematics and science achievement of students in Year 4 and Year

8 in 25 and 46 countries respectively including Australia.

Australia's results from TIMSS 2002/03 will be reported in two volumes Summing it up:

Mathematics achievement in Australian schools in TIMSS 2002 and Examining the

evidence: Science achievement in Australian schools in TIMSS 2002 both by Sue

Thomson and Nicole Fleming.

The release of the Australian results will coincide with the release of the international

report by the International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement

(IEA) in Boston.
