Thomas M. Achenbach

Thomas M. Achenbach is the Professor of Psychiatry and Psychology, and Director of the Centre for Children, Youth, and Families at the University of Vermont Department of Psychiatry. He has written and co-authored over 200 publications including *Developmental Psychopathology*, *Research in Developmental Psychology: Concepts, Strategies, Methods*, *Manuals for the Child Behaviour Checklist*, and a range of standardised assessment instruments.

Gale Roid

Gale Roid is the Dunn Professor of Educational and Psychological Assessment, Department of Special Education, Peabody College of Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tennessee. Author of the well-respected *Stanford-Binet Intelligence Scales 5th Edition*, Professor Roid has also co-authored the *Stoelting Brief Nonverbal Intelligence Test (S-BIT)* and the *Leiter International Performance Scale – Revised*.
